

BILL OF RIGHTS TREASURE CHEST

Objective: Students are expected to show their understanding of each of the Personal Freedoms listed in the Bill of Rights by making a Treasure Chest.

Using your knowledge of the Bill of Rights and your packet you will create your Treasure Chest of the Bill of Rights. You will use a paper bag, shoe box, etc to make your “Chest” for your Treasures. Decorate it, and include on it why you think these rights are “Treasures” of all Americans. Inside your Treasure Chest you will include one Item for each Right. *There are 14 total Rights in the Bill of Rights.* An item can be the following: picture showing the right being used, a collage describing the right, a Drawing of the right, or an actual item i.e.- cross, protest sign (NO TOY GUNS). You should include on the back or tied on to your item the Amendment number being show and the right you are describing.
