## Civil War Timeline Project

## Due:

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Objective: The students will create a individual timeline of the major events of the Civil War including: Antietam, Emancipation Proclamation, Battle of Gettysburg, Firing on Fort Sumter, Siege of Vicksburg, Appomattox Court House, and the Assassination of Lincoln. In each event the student must include: title, date, winner (if possible), what is the significance of that event, and a picture. The timeline will be put in chronological order and include illustrations and descriptions to match title.
