### WEST OF THE APPALACHIANS


1. About

## LOUISIANA PURCHASE


1. Jefferson sent James Monroe to France to buy New Orleans for \$10 million



2. Napoleon, needing to fund wars, offered all of Louisiana territory for just \$15million
