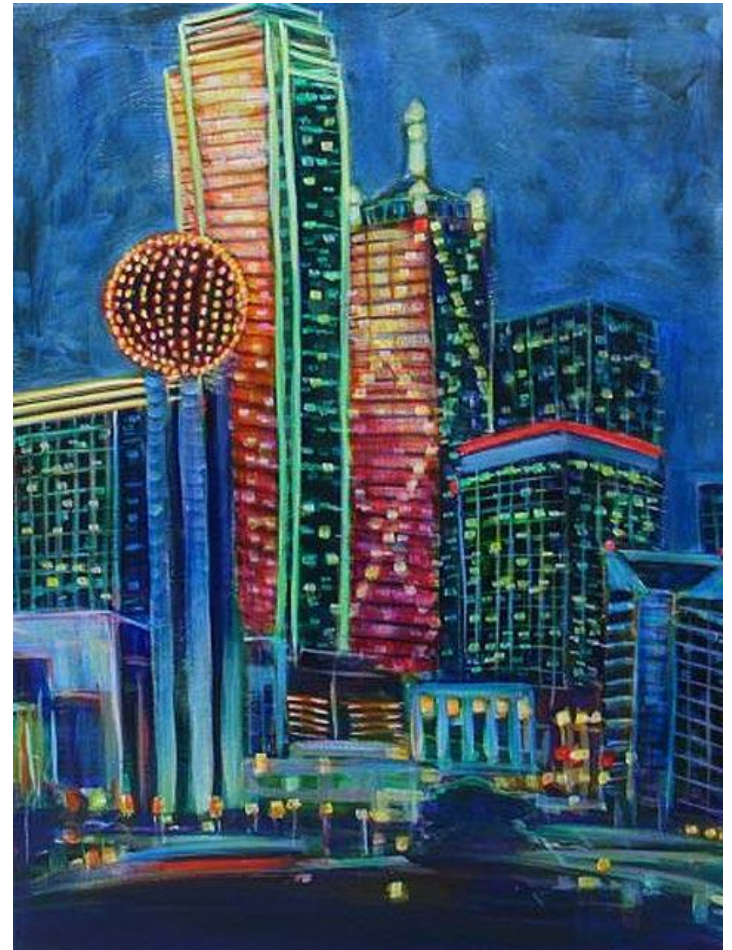

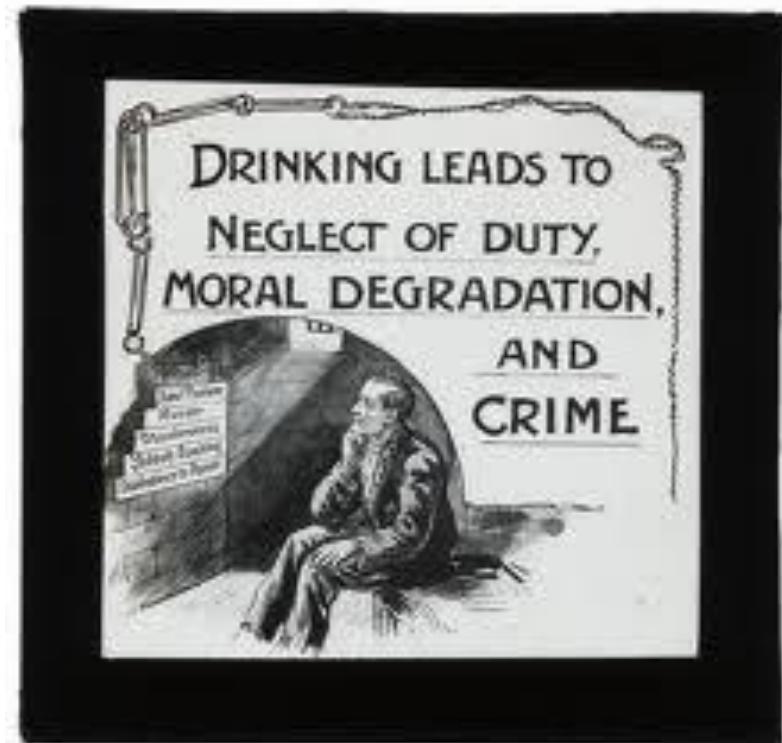

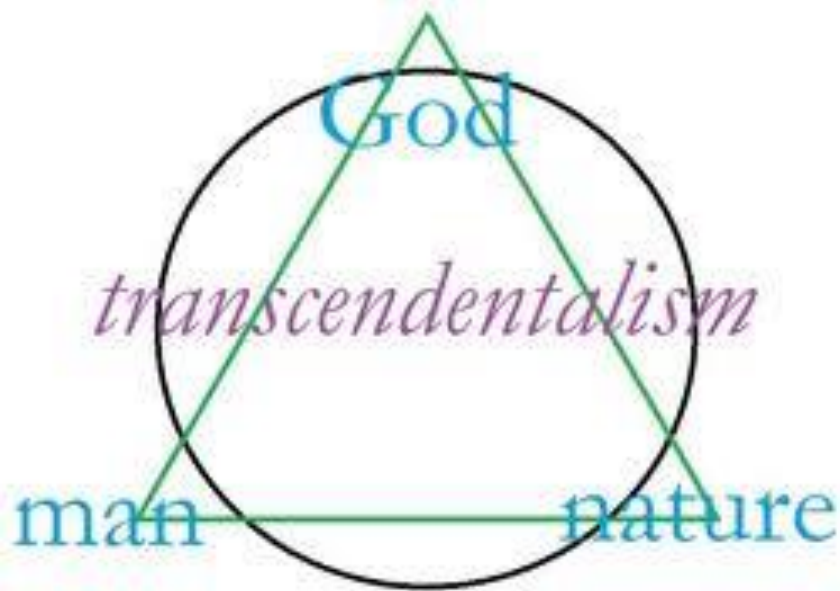
# TEMPERANCE MOVEMENT

consumption



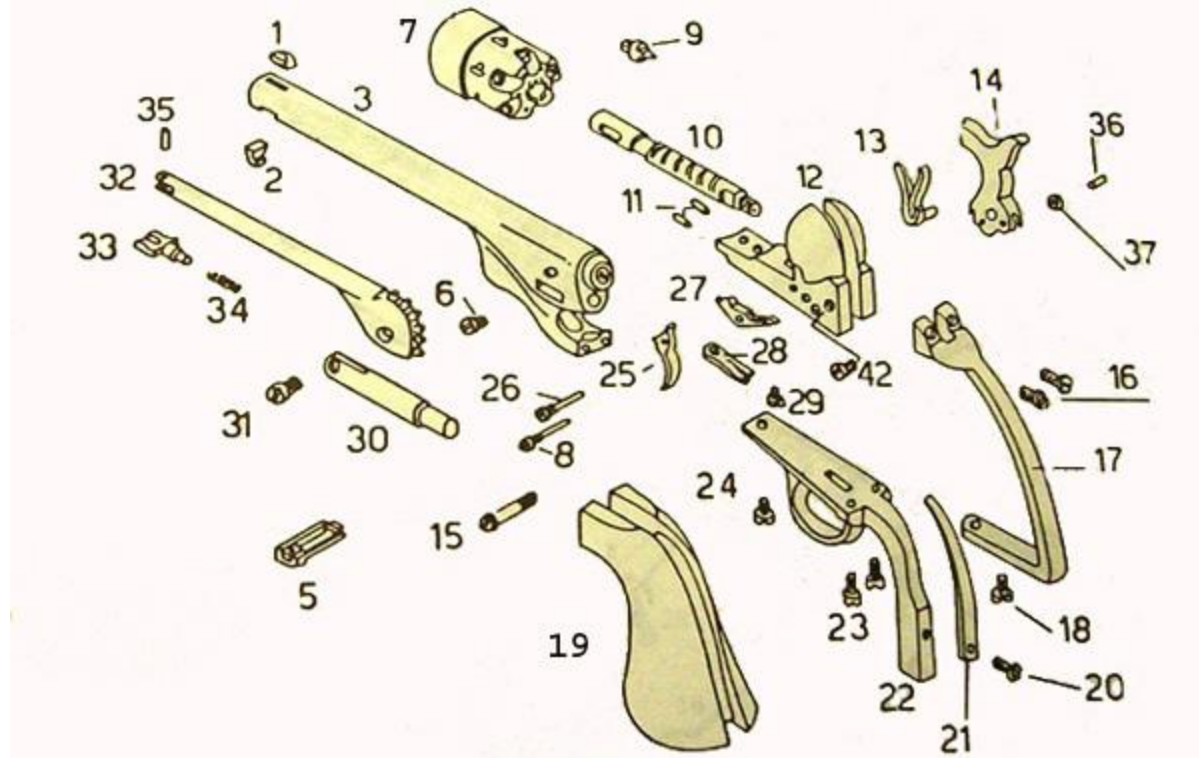
# TRANSCENDENTALISM

or instrument

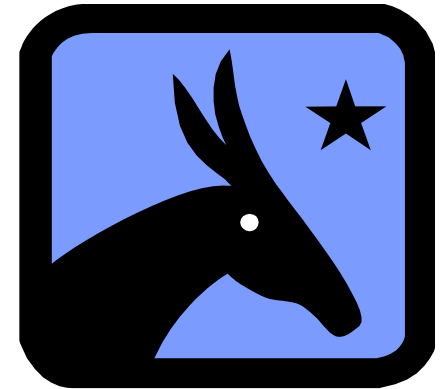
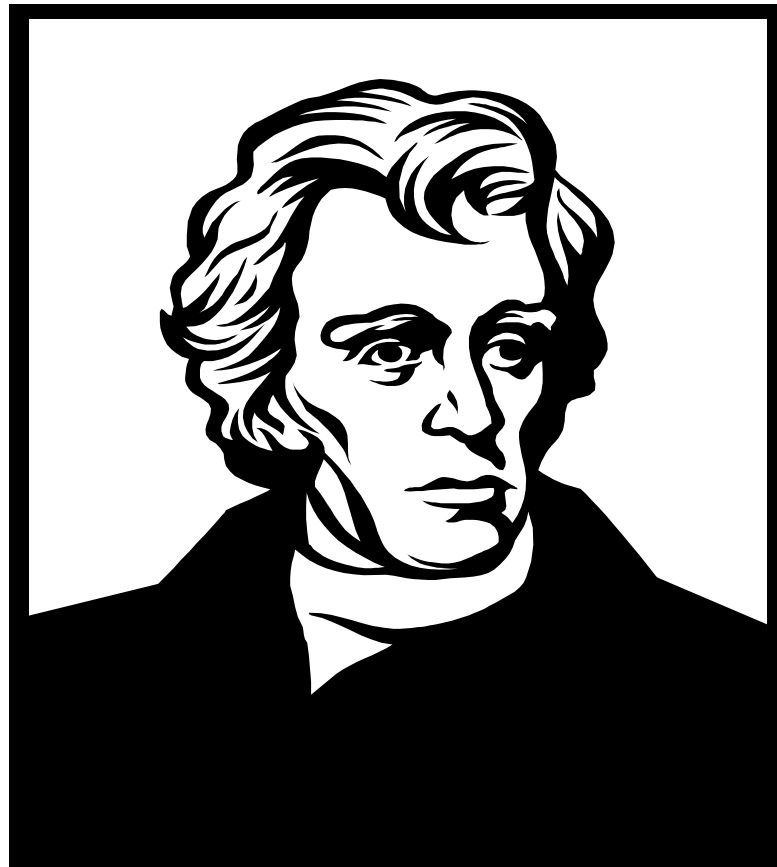

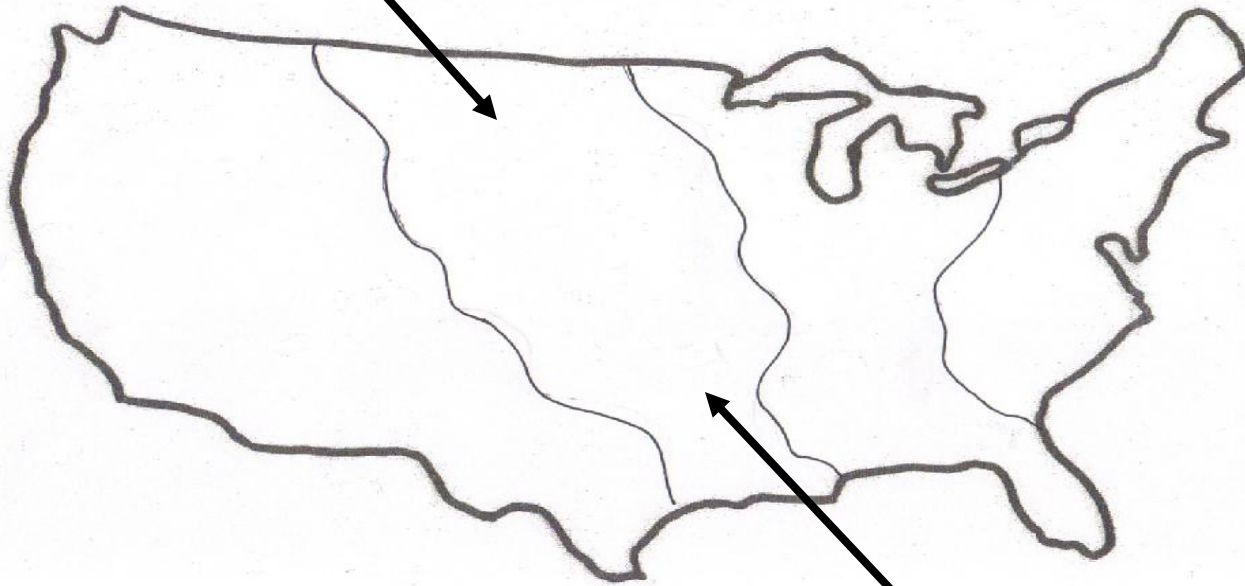

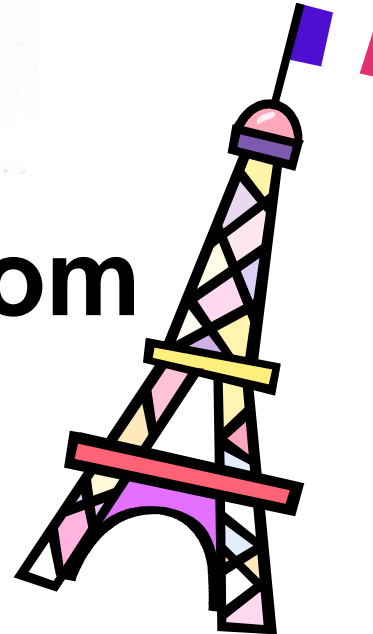

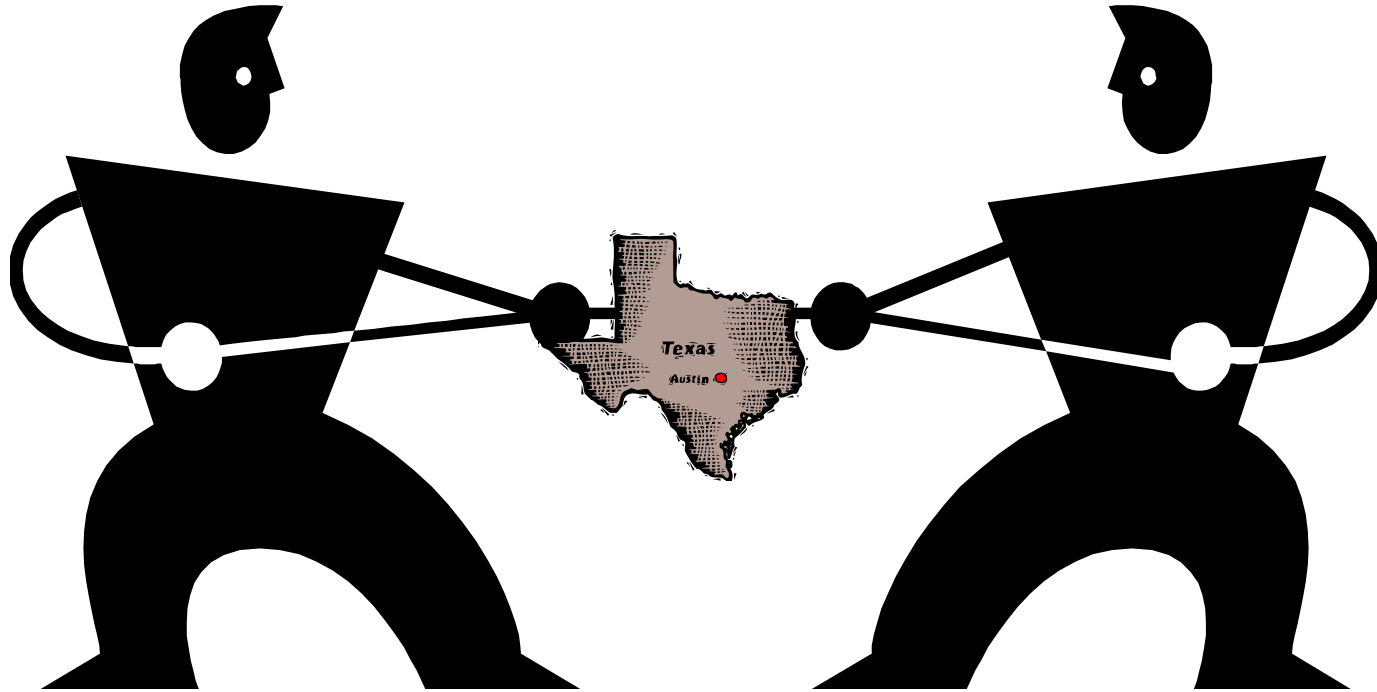
Machine used to separate cotton seeds from fibers- Eli Whitney

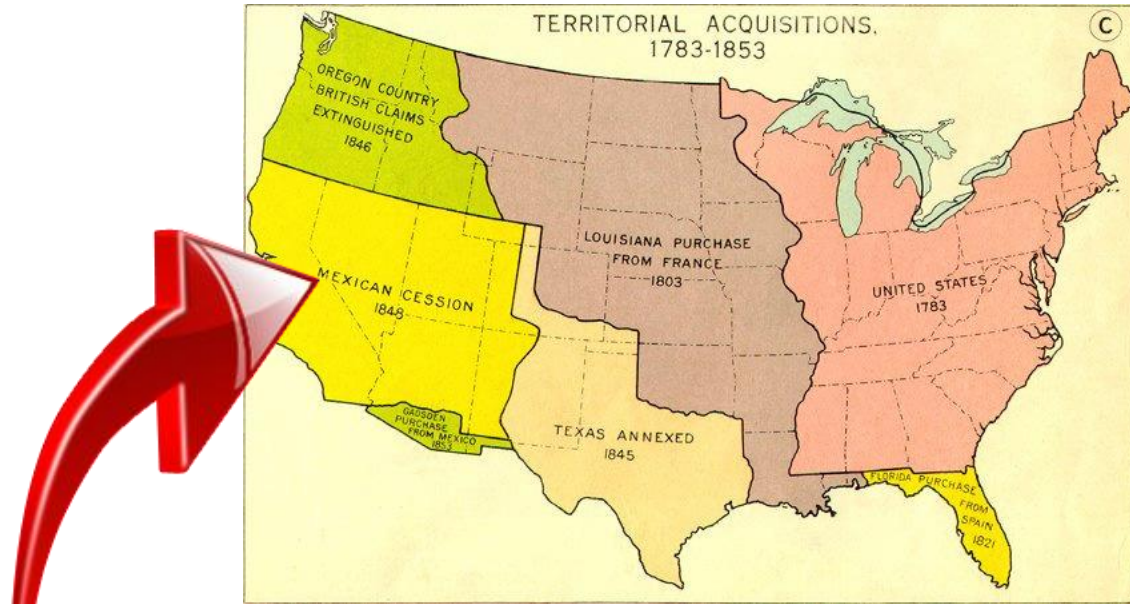

# MEXICAN WAR



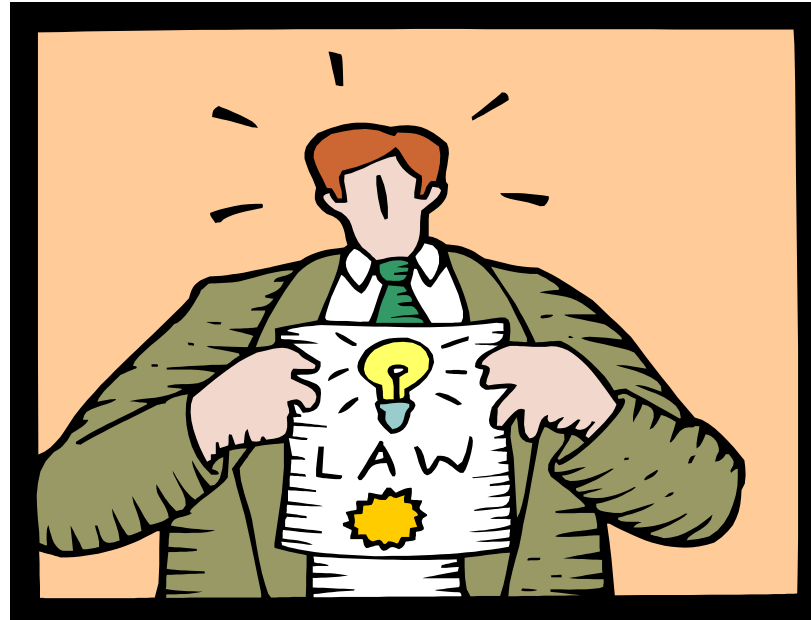
**War between Mexico and the US, Caused
